Lasting impact in Europe

Recently we received GREAT reports of how Ukraine is still responding to the March of Life held there in August of 2010. Pastors all over the nation are taking responsibility to "break the silence" of indifference and anti-semitism. Many of them met at the Babiyar memorial in Kiev for the one year anniversary of the march held in 18 cities of Ukraine to discuss ways to continue what began there last year.

GERMAN TOUR - SEPT 2011

For the month of September, I was in Europe for a 3 week tour of Germany and another March of Life, this time in Lithuania. I started in Tubingen with Paul Wilbur recording his latest album (featuring 2 of my songs) completely in German for the grand opening ceremonies for the new building of TOS Church. From there I held concerts in churches and congregations all over Germany including Trier, Dortmund, Reichenbach, Mittleweide, Lichenstein, Dresden, & Berlin. I was hosted by "Saxon Friends of Israel" and revisited several cities March of Life II had impacted in 2008.



March of Life - Lithuania

Barely a month ago, we returned from The March of Life in Lithuania, where, again, we changed a nation. My dear friends at TOS Church in Tubingen Germany organized Christians from all over that nation to gather and take a public prayer walk from the former ghettos to the main squares of 7 cities, symbolic of welcoming Jewish life back to

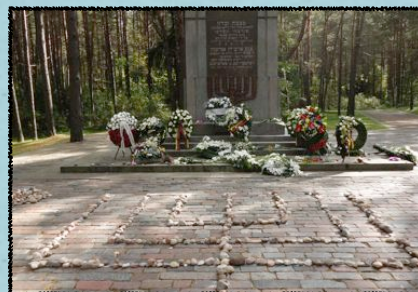
Lithuania. The lone survivor of the Ponerius massacre (where 100,000 people were murdered, mostly Jewish) said she had waited 70 years to see one Lithuanian admit that it had happened. The small remaining Jewish community no longer stands alone, as Lithuanians put on the yellow Star of David and walked through 7 cities of the nation



KOVNO LITHUANIA - The Lithuanian government declared a Holocaust Remembrance Day for the first time in 70 years to support our march.



VILNIUS LITHUANIA Hundreds of Christians and Jews gathered in front of the Capitol building to declare "Never Again" and to welcome Jewish life back to Lithuania.



PONERIUS - We marched to the sites of many mass graves including this one outside of Vilnius where 100,000 people were murdered in about 6 months time.

I’ve been touring nonstop since 2006 and October was no exception. After playing in Montgomery Alabama on Oct 26th, I drove to Atlanta to catch a plane to Washington DC for the initial planning meeting for March of Remembrance 2012. (See page 3)

At the meeting, a friend offered to help me financially to start another recording project, and Pastor Bittner of TOS Church also offered support so on Friday Oct 28th I flew home and started calling musicians and studios

to see if I could record an album while home for 6 days. Impossible, right?

Well, long story short, I got 2 percussion players, an upright bass, a piano player and a clarinet player to show up at Yorktown Digital in Irving TX and passed out chord charts. I’d show them the songs, then we’d record it “live” and go to the next

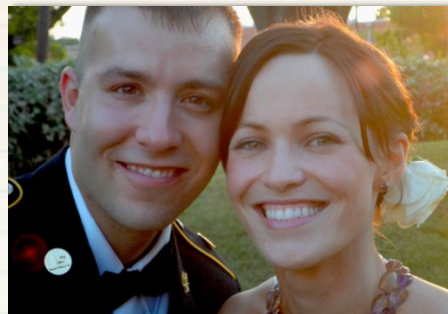
song. 7 1/2 hours later we had 10 songs done. We were recorded, mixed, and mastered by Phil York, 3 time Grammy winner and he loved the music so much that he has already submitted it for a Grammy.

In 3 days time the album was sent to manufacturing and is already on my website for digital downloads.

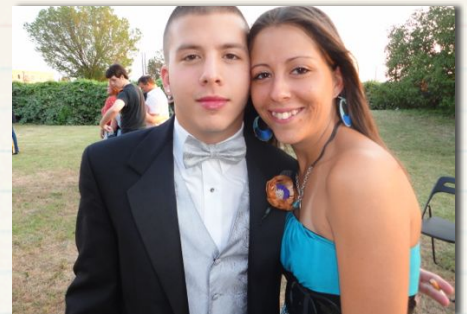
THE BOYS: WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

March of Remembrance Manhattan

...

2012 will start with a prayer walk in New York City to the United Nations on April 15, 2012. About 50 descendants of Nazis will come from Germany to publicly renounce what their fathers did and declare "Never Again!" in a public stand against anti-semitism. Many NYC area churches will join us in a march from Madison Square Garden (where 50,000 American Nazis rallied in 1939) to the United Nations for a public event.

MARCH OF REMEMBRANCE USA

The following Sunday, April 22, is the observance of Yom HaShoah and the date chosen for the annual March of Remembrance. The main event will be again be held in Washington DC and simultaneously in cities all over the USA, and internationally to break the silence of indifference towards the Jewish people and Israel.
